

# Kṛṣṇa Kills Aghāsura and Bewilders Lord Brahmā

  - Physical violence

  - Spiritual violence (Faith-breaking violence)
4. (a) When violence is appropriate and beneficial.  
(b) Śrīla Prabhupāda’s definition of *ahimsā* (Bg 13.8-12 p)  
(c) When self-interest and lack of foresight is violence (*Prabhupāda Nectar* 5.40)
5. **A Reality Check:**  
**Am I harming or helping my Gurudeva by being his disciple?:**
  - Am I faithfully following the vows I made to him? (*What is the Difficulty?*, Page 187)
  - As his disciple, am I faithfully presenting and representing Śrīla Prabhupāda’s teachings? (*What is the Difficulty?*, Page 134 + *Prabhupāda Nectar* 5.49)
  - Am I a conscious disciple? (*Prabhupāda Nectar* 4.11, Beginning “What is that?”)
  - Am I a Kṛṣṇa conscious disciple? (*Prabhupāda Nectar* 4.48, Story beginning “During a Sunday feast”..., *Prabhupāda Nectar* 5.6, Beginning “Once in Hyderabad”...)
6. A useful meditation for dealing with this *anartha* (malice): ŚB 12.11.24 p
