### WHY RÅDHÅ KUËÖA IS SO EXALTED

- \* Belongs to Çrëmatë Rådihåréë, who is the most beloved of Kåñëa
- \* Is as dear to Kåñëa as Rådihå Herself.
- \* Very rarely attained, even by great personalities fully engaged in devotional service
- \* A devotee will at once develop pure love of Kåñëa in the wake of the gopë if he once takes bath in Rådihå-kuëöa

#### RÅDHÅ-KUËÖA:

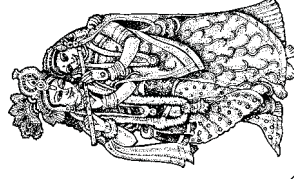
- \* Çrëla Rûpa Gosvåmë recommends that one should take a bath in Rådihå-kuëöa as many times as possible
- \* He says this is a most important item in the execution of devotional service

### ÇRÉLA BHAKTIVINODA ÖHÅKURA WRITES:

- \* Rådihå-kuëöa is the most select place for those wishing to follow in the footsteps of the sakihå and mai jarë.
- \* Those eager to return to Goloka Våndåvana by means of attaining their siddha-deha should live at Rådihå-kuëöa, take shelter of maidservants of Çrë Rådihå, and engage constantly in Her service under their direction.
- \* This is the most exalted method for those engaged in devotional service under the protection of Çrë Caitanya Mahåprabhu.

### ÇRÉLA BHAKTISIDDHÅNTA SARASVATÉ ÖHÅKURA WRITES:

- \* To take bath in Rådihå-kuëöa is a rare privilege
- \* Even Nārada and Sanaka don't get the opportunity
- \* If, by great fortune one attains the opportunity, he should bathe regularly giving up all material conceptions, taking shelter of Çrë Rådihå and Her assistant gopë.
- \* Such constant engagement during this lifetime will result in returning Home to serve Çrë Rådihå as contemplated during one's life on the banks of Rådihå-kuëöa.
