Srila Prabhupada on Prayasa



Atyahara (collecting and eating more than required) leads to prayasa.

Don't collect too many goods.

Don't eat too much.

Don't work unnecessarily to possess artificial amenities.



Higher intelligence must be utilised to understand God and to understand the ultimate goal of life.

Misuse of intelligence leads to opening of unnecessary things like factories, brothels, liquor shops, etc.

Accept a favourable occupation to maintain your body and family

Accept a favourable occupation which one can easily perform and which gives a person sufficient time to practice Krishna consciousness.

Proper Human dharma All occupational engagements (dharma) should be performed for liberation. They should never be performed for material gain.

Furthermore, one should never use material gain to cultivate sense gratification.

Without dharma, human society is no better than animal society

In human society there are various religious conceptions, characterized as Hindu, Christian, Hebrew, Mohammedan, Buddhist and so on.

True religion

True religion instructs people to be satisfied with the bare necessities of life while cultivating Krishna consciousness.

One should not be enthusiastic for huge undertakings.


How much to endeavour?

Visaya prayasa- endeavouring for undesirable things is forbidden.


To become 'big' at the cost of others is undesirable prayas.
