At first, deception comes in harmless ways

Person given extra change, he thinks," A nice way to earn money."

Sometimes a person jokes, and for being witty he slightly exaggerates


Sometimes a person argues and in the heat of debate he resorts to lies.

Gradually, a person becomes accustomed to behaving in this way.

These small sins or innocent trifles turn into offenses.

Deception turns into offensive behaviour





The mind gets burnt: it is always in anxiety to protect the hypocritical act.

Soul gets burnt in 3 ways : (

- 1. Unless the deception is given up, the soul can not progress towards Krishna.
 - Deceptive behaviour gradually leads to offenses which steals away our devotional credits.
 - 3. Offenses burn the soul by gradually taking away the desire to serve Krishna.




If we Lack of faith & respect in our spiritual preceptors We will not absorb our mind and heart in their teachings.

Because of lack of faith, we watch TV or movies and we justify it saying that we need it for our preaching.

Then we end up absorbing our minds in asat sanga.

This leads to spiteful talk, back biting which leads to cruelty and ultimately into violence.

4 essential qualities of a devotee

- 2. Being focused on the purpose.

Litmus test for gauging our sincerity to attain Krishna

Respect towards Krishna's tadiya (things,places,persons,objects etc)
