BVT's 4 manifestations of hṛdaya daurbalyam,

1. tucchāsaktiḥ śakti—attachment to things that are not related to Kṛṣṇa;
2. kuṭināṭī or duplicity, hypocrisy;
3. mātsaryam—envy of others' progress which leads to slander,
4. pratiṣṭhāśā—the desire for fame.

6 enemies

1. kāma,
2. krodha,
3. lobha,
4. moha,
5. mada
6. mātsarya:

6 Waves

1. hunger,
2. thirst,
3. old age,
4. death,
5. grief,
6. illusion.

SGS - pratiṣṭhā is the root of all other anarthas.
BSST's - pig's excrement.
Kavi Karnapura' - If one thing has remained, all the rest will come back."
ŚP 's pratiṣṭhā gives rise to jīva-himsā (hardhearted)
