Two ways to serve the deity: archanam and paricharya

paricharya

performing menial services to the deity special privilege for those who are not qualified to touch the deity , who are not second initiated

Darshan

patiently stand and adore the deities, appreciate them, offer prayers to them

Home deities- second initiation not needed For householders, deities should be the centre of the house.

23. hearing the name, form, qualities and pastimes of the Lord

24. accepting the mercy of the Lord

tat te 'nukampām su-samīkṣamāṇo bhuñjāna evātma-kṛtam vipākam hṛd-vāg-vapurbhir vidadhan namas te jīveta yo mukti-pade sa dāya-bhāk

Accepting any situation as Krishna's mercy.

Prayers to be offered to the Lord:

"Krishna ,pls give me the strength to go through this situation."

"Krishna, pls give me the right perspective."

"Krishna, pls give me the intelligence to see how you have mercifully planned the whole thing for me."

"My Lord, pls do what you think is the best for me."

25.remembrance of the Lord

Smaranam is inferior to sravanam kirtanam because it can not be practiced by materialistic persons.

For them it is difficult to remember Lord.

nam,rupa,guna,lila smaranam

26. meditating on the Lord

seva dhyanam: Brahmana of pratisthapura

27. acting as a servant of the Lord

dasyam/kainkaryam: mood of being the servant of the Lord mood of always being available for the master mood of 'what can I do for you my dear Lord'

28. thinking of the Lord as a friend

sakhyam or mitravritti possible only at the stage of bhava or raganuga sadhana

29. offering oneself to the Lord

atma nivedana offering one's body completely in the service of the Lord. manas deho je kichu mora...

possible only in raganuga sadhana or bhava

30. offering the best items to the Lord

31. making full efforts for the Lord

32.surrendering to the Lord

consciously practice the 6 limbs of surrender

- ānukūlyasya sankalpa accepting only what is favorable for bhakti.
 pratikūlyasya varjanam rejecting everything unfavorable for bhakti.
 rakṣhiṣhyatīti viśhvāso having faith that Sri Krishna will assuredly grant His protection.
 - 4) goptritve varanam accepting Krishna as one's only maintainer.
 - 5) ātmanikṣhepa complete submission of oneself to Krishna
 - 6) kārpaṇye feeling meek, humble, insignificant, etc experience of one's own lamentable condition

ya drsta nikhila agha sangha samani sprsta vapuh pavani roganam abhivandita nirasini siktantaka trasini pratya satti vidhayini bhagavatah krsnasya samropita nyasta taccarane vimukti phalada tasyai namah (Hari Bhakti Vilasa 9/104 from Skanda Purana, Avanti khanda)

Just by looking at you (Tulasi), all sins become removed.

Just by touching you, one's body becomes pure.

By praying to Her, all diseases practically become removed.

If one waters Her or makes Her wet, the fear of Yamaraja (death personified) is destroyed. Just by planting or transplanting, one achieves nearness to the Supreme Personality of Godhead. If someone offers Tulasi at the lotus feet of Lord Sri Krsna, She awards liberation and devotion to Him, therefore I pay my humble obeisances to such a wonderful Tulasi-devi.

34. studying the scriptures (those written or commented upon by our acharyas)

5 most potent angas of devotional service

40. having <u>faith and great affection</u> for serving the deity (archanam is an important limb but it becomes very potent limb if one has great faith and affection)

41. Relishing Bhägavatam in association of devotees
(Studying Bhagavatam is an important limb but it becomes a very potent limb when we relish the deep inner meaning of Bhagavatam in the association of like minded devotees)

42. Associating with <u>like-minded</u>, <u>affectionate</u>, <u>superior</u> devotees (and not just associating with devotees)

Like -mindedness varies from stage to stage.

stage 1: any devotee is like minded.

stage 2: any ISKCON devotee is like minded.

stage 3: those who like the same limbs of devotional service.

- those who share the same definition of success in bhakti

stage 4: same rasa in raganuga bhakti
