8th offense

9th offense
Giving the name to Unfaithful

- ★ **Atheistic and people extremely entangled with moral rules or duties of karma cannot take up chanting the Name unless they first purify their hearts.**
- ★ **To give such unqualified and faithless people the teachings of the Name is as useless as sowing seeds on barren ground.**
- ★ **Those who give out the Name motivated by receiving substantial donations are selling the Name.**

10th offense

Even after hearing the glories of the Name, the sense of possessiveness and attachment is so strong that they do not develop an attachment for the Name.
