


I always see the cows; Let the cows see me always; Our attention should be towards cows; Their attention should be towards us; We are for the cows and the cows are for us.



Worship Cows and Serve








- 1. One should circumambulate the cow in Brahma muhurta one will get the piety of bathing in Ganges and sins of the day will be nullified.

Learn from Lord Krishna





Gomata - Embodiment of all demigods





King Dilipa's devotion towards the celestial Cow, Nandini




The story of Dilipa is immortalized by Kalidasa in his epic, Raghuvamsa.

It is a symbol of love and sacrifice




Cultural importance of cows



- * In Indian tradition the bride enters her husband's house (after marriage), for the first time, in the 'Godhuli lagna' meaning, the time when cows return home after grazing.
- * During 'Griha Pravesham' or house warming ceremony of a newly built house, the cow is made to enter the house first.
- * In India the lady of the house is supposed to worship the cow every morning.
- * At day break people feed rice, jiggery, banana etc. to the cows.
- * Cow is worshipped everywhere in India, especially in the month of kartika.
- * Only cow's milk is offered to God's.
- * Many Indians consume cow's urine, as part of Panchagavya.
- * In vedic tradition, cowdung is used to clean the floor.
- * The dried and powdered cowdung is used as sacred ash.



- * It contributes to immunity power.


 It is not only non-poisonous but also destroys poison.




Prevents nose bleed if few drops are instilled

Cow ghee (clarified butter), when poured on burning cow dung cakes, produces copious amounts of oxygen and purifies the air. Studies have proven this and it has been suggested as a tool to fight air pollution.

On 4th May 1985, a news was published in India's national daily, The Hindu, in connection with Bhopal gas tragedy. The news was titled 'Vedic way to beat pollution'.

On the fateful night of December 3, 1984, poisonous MIC gas leaked from Union Carbide plant in Bhopal, India, killing thousands and sickening many more. There were, however two families, Sohan Lal Khushwaha and M. L. Rathore, who lived in the worst affected area but came our unscathed. Later enquiries revealed that both the families were regularly performing yajna or fire sacrifice with cow dung and butter. No casualties were reported from any of the families despite living in the worst hit area. Therefore cow dung is never considered to be feces but a great purifiter.

Prescribed dose:


- 1. 10 ml in the morning along with milk or water
- 2. 10 ml in the evening along with milk or water

- Edema
- Severe Jaundice

- Mental Retardation




Pancha-Gavyam and its effects

our prime responsibility is to protect and glorify cows.






The Goal

Establishing cow protection will rid us of vast environmental, ecological, and sociological problems, and also help us to create a spiritual, peaceful environment for the future.




